# MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

2018 was an incredible year of growth, change, and rising to unique challenges for the Rape Recovery Center community. We continue to see an increasing number of survivors embracing their #MeToo stories and raising their voices by reporting their assaults, sharing their experiences on social media, or seeking support in their healing journey. Our center served a record 1,895 survivors in 2018, a stunning 61% increase in just one year.

Along with this increase in services, we have been inspired by the many community members and organizations who have supported our center throughout this year. We are so grateful for the many supporters who volunteered their time, coordinated service projects, hosted fundraisers, and donated their own resources to help our organization grow. Our circles of support continue to grow as our community seeks opportunities to join our movement to build a culture of consent and healing.

Though our community of survivors and supporters grows, we continue to face challenges within our changing cultural landscape. This fall, as the supreme court hearings brought forward brave testimony from Dr. Christine Blasey Ford, we felt the impact of the disbelief and victim blaming from those in positions of power. Immediately after this high profile national event, our crisis line was flooded with calls from survivors struggling to cope with the negative messages they were hearing surrounding this powerful testimony.

As we move into 2019, we are ready to engage with our allies and look forward to continued growth as we build toward our vision of a future free from sexual violence.



3,520 REFERRALS to other providers and services.

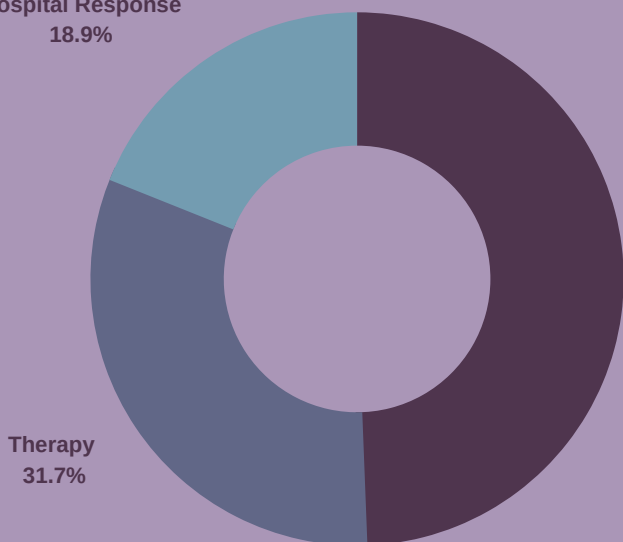

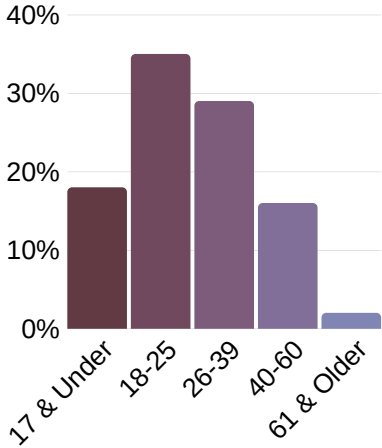

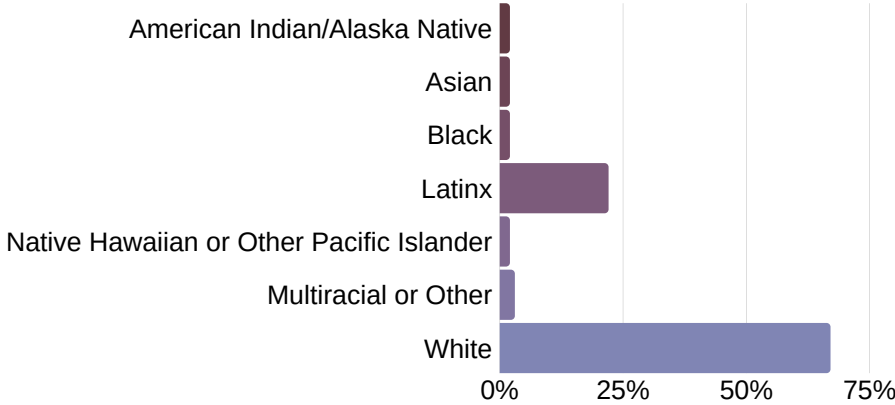
## Gender Identity

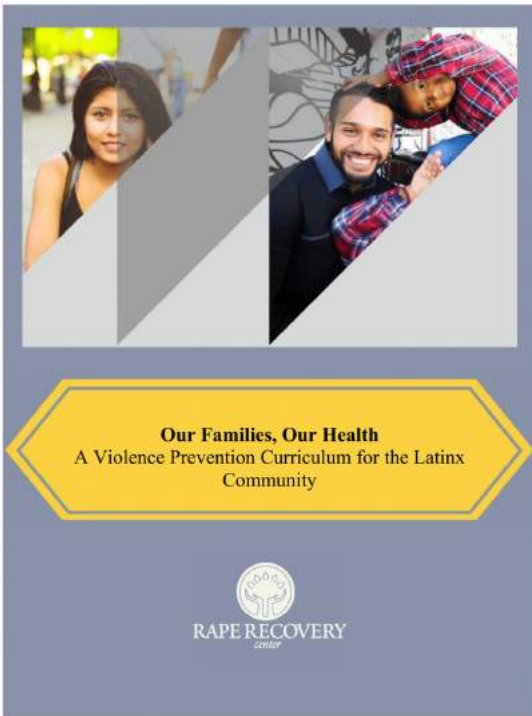

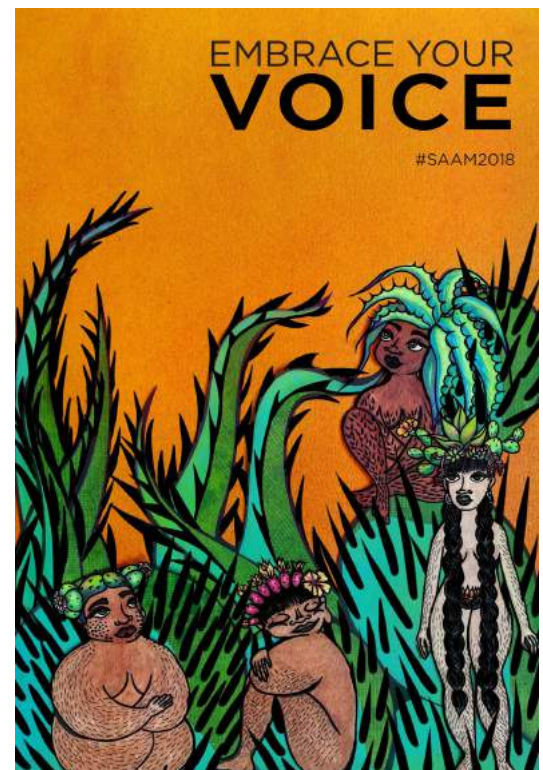

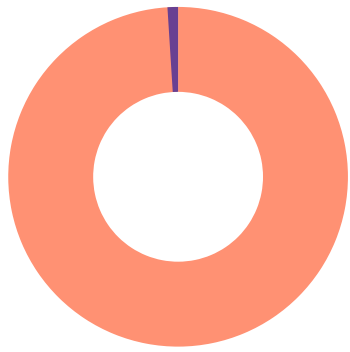
## SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS MONTH

- Each April, the Rape Recovery Center celebrates Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM)
- The 2018 SAAM theme was "Embrace Your Voice"
- In 2018, our center hosted 6 SAAM events
- Approximately 500 community members participated in our SAAM events throughout the month

**FAMILIES WHO PARTICIPATED IN OUR SEXUAL VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAM:**

**Increased non-violent problem solving skills**



- More likely to ask someone for advice on how to handle a situation where they are angry
- More likely to listen to the other person's side of the story when they were angry at them
- More likely to ask the other person how they were feeling when they were angry at them

**Decreased attitudes that promote sexual violence**



- More likely to disagree with the statement "girls are always trying to manipulate boys"
- More likely to agree that it is okay for a boy to say no to physical contact
- More likely to agree with the statement "if me or someone I know is experiencing a problem like domestic violence, sexual violence, or bullying, I know at least one person I can trust and go to for help"

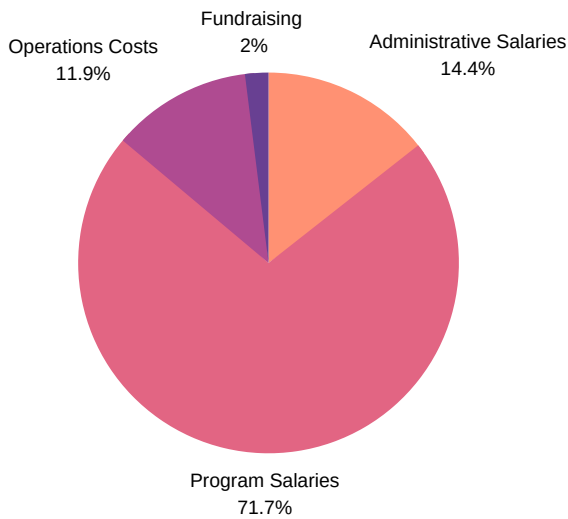
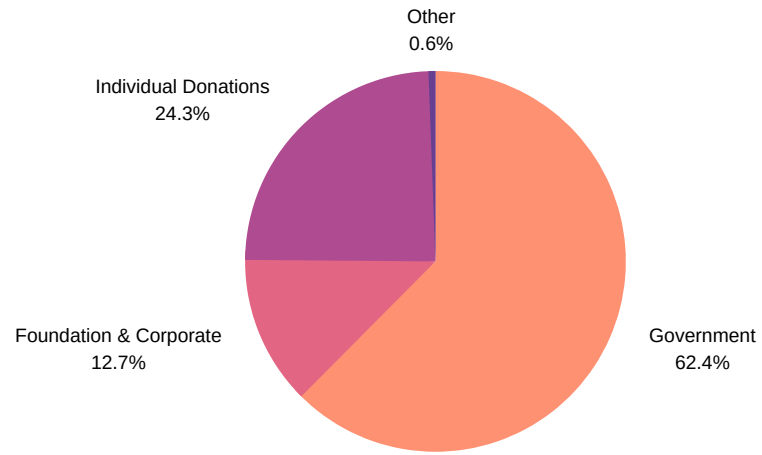
